NATURAL RESOURCE CONFERENCE ROOM APRIL 11, 1984

CALL TO ORDER (Item No. 1)

Chairman, Donald Malnourie called the meeting to order at 10:47 A.M. Malnourie appointed Tillie Walker as Acting Secretary.

ROLL CALL (Item NO. 2)

PRESENT: Donald Malnourie, Pete Coffey, Sr., Tillie Walker, Ernest Stone - sitting in. Gerald White came in at approximately 11:00 A.M.

OTHERS PRESENT: Arnie Guimont, Amy Henry, Norma Staples, Steve Wells, Mark A. Charging, Gerald Fox, Rachel Bell, Ken Deane, and Theola F. Fox - Recording Secretary.

ITEM NO. 3 GERALD FOX - APPEAL OF TERMINATION

Amy Henry, Personnel Director, started off the discussion by reading the Letter of Appeal that was submitted to her office by Gerald Fox. Then Any read the following letters all addressed to Gerald Fox: Letter of Warning, Letter of Two (2) Weeks Suspension, and the Letter of Termination. Amy stated that according to these letters, all of the steps were followed as is written in the Three Affiliated Tribes Personnel Policies and Procedures. Discussion followed. After all sides were heard Donald Malnourie asked for a motion in changing the terminology of Gerald's letter of Termination from terminated to laid-off, so Gerald Fox could receive unemployment benefits.

MOTION NO. 1 - Moved by Walker that the statement terminated, on Gerald's letter, be changed to laid-off. Seconded by Pete Coffey. VOTE: Four (4) in favor. One (1) abstaining, motion carried.

ITEM NO. 4 FUEL ASSISTANCE APPLICATIONS

MOTION NO. 2 - Moved by Coffey to approve all of the following applicants for fuel assistance: David Charging, Sr., Fannie Whiteman, Roman J. Canyon, Albert Couture Sr., Joseph Deane Jr., Clarinda Gohl, and Louella Young Bird. Seconded by Tillie Walker. VOTE: Unanimous, motion carried.

ITEM NO. 5 HOUSING REHABILITATION APPLICATIONS

After a lengthy discussion on all the applicants who applied for Housing Rehabilitation, it was decided that no further action will be taken on these applicants until reasons were applied to the names on the list as to why some are being helped and some are not. Donald Malnourie stated that Arnie and Steve should try to give more help to some of the people across the river like Twin Buttes. He stated that most people who are helped are in the New Town area. ITEM NO. 7 201 WASTE WATER TREATMENT STUDY

> Ken Deane told the Committee that the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) was sending a revised waste water treatment plan to him next week. He talked about the systems across the road, the clinic and the Drags Wolf Village. Ken suggested to the Committee that they have a look at the revised plan first, before the meeting tentatively set for June 20, 1984. He asked if the Committee would like to look at the plan at the next Material Resource Committee Meeting which would be held Wednesday, April 18, 1984. Don stated that the would like to see the plan at the next meeting. Ken stated he would present it to the Committee at that time.

ITEM NO. 8 UTILITIES DEPARTMENT

Rachel Bell gave a Resolution to Donald Malnourie that stated that a front-end loader and a tractor belonged to the Utilities Department, to keep the Tribal Administration grounds in good shape. Arnie was handed the Resolution by Mr. Malnourie and asked to keep it for the files.
