- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act; and
- whereas, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, One of the Tribal Business Council's Economic Development Priorities is to ensure that the Mandaree Electronics enterprise receives technical assistance for achieving SBA 8a status and acquiring work contracts; and
- WHEREAS, The Council of Energy Resource Tribes (CERT) offices in Denver is a national organization providing technical assistance to CERT member Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, This technical assistance is usually provided to the CERT member at no cost to the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, CERT requires a Tribal Resolution allowing it to provide technical assistance services on the Reservation on a project basis.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes hereby requests the Council of Energy Resource Tribes (CERT) to provide technical assistance services to the Mandaree Electronics firm and to coordinate those services with Shawn Fredericks, Chief Executive Officer, Mandaree Electronics Corporation with the goal being to qualify Mandaree Electronics to achieve SBA 8a status and the ability to achieve contracts.

Vice-chairman Lone Fight made a motion to approve both resolutions presented by the dialysis program, seconded by Councilman Hall.

Discussion on if the administrators had spoken with Dr. Herbert J. Wilson regarding housing of the project. Max explained that they don't have any office space in terms of administrative staff. Construction and leasing were discussed. Darryl Hall, Administrative Assistant elaborated further that in talking with Mrs. Herbert Wilson, she stated that they were saving space for a Doctor that will be coming in the near future.

Vice Chairman Lone Fight made a motion to approve Rupert and Associates Technical Assistance Resolution, seconded by Councilman Gillette.

Discussion on how this will be paid questioned by Treasurer Bird Bear. It was explained these companies and others are already being paid by the federal government to assist tribal entities or other organizations requesting services.

The only one that is different from the others, is Matthew Mason's, which is a Net Recovery Buy Out plan.
