Getting Credentialed in MyGov.

What is a Collaborator Account?

This is the most basic access into the MyGov. System. You will be able view limited information and also receive limited information.

What is a credential?

This allows you to be added to a project for a trade specific category. This is needed to be able to apply for your permits. This gives much more access to be able to comments and upload information to a project.

Who needs a credential?

The general contractor, all of their subs and any other project specific staff, such as civil and structural engineers, architects, and any project management staff tribal or otherwise that needs to be able to track a project.


What is needed for a credential?

The basic documents that you will need: MHA Tero license, State business and/or Contracting license, Picture ID, Workman's Comp Info, and Limited Liability Information. Some credentials do not require this much information such as tribal project managers, the information that they provide is much simpler.

When do I get credentialed?

Right after you have all of your documentation and have set up your collaborator account. You will not be able to complete a permit without it.
