

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution entitled, "Consent to Assignment of a Right-of-Way across Tribal land (Tract T636A)"

- WHEREAS, The Mandan Hidatsa and Arikara Nation (the "Nation"), also known as the Three Affiliated Tribes, having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, the authority under said Act, and having adopted a Constitution and Bylaws (the "Constitution") under said Act, and
- WHEREAS, Pursuant to Article III, Section 1 of the Constitution, the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, Pursuant to Article VI, Section 5(1) of the Constitution, the Tribal Business Council has the power to adopt Resolutions regulating the procedures of the Tribal Council, its Agencies and Officials; and
- WHEREAS, Article IX, Sections 1 and 3 of the Constitution, provides that the Tribal Business Council has the authority to manage and lease or otherwise deal with tribal lands and resources; and
- WHEREAS, Leases and Rights-of-Way ("ROWs") across Tribal Trust land require the consent of the Tribal Business Council pursuant to federal and Tribal Law; and
- WHEREAS, Applications for Rights-of-Way ("ROWs") on Tribal Land are subject to the requirements of tribal law, including Resolution No. 13-109-VJB (Establishing Standardized Minimum Rates for Oil and Gas Lease Bonus, Royalties and Road and Pipeline Easements), Resolution No. 14-071-VJB (MHA Nation Application for Rights-of-Way and Use of Right-of-Way), Resolution No. 14-089-VJB (MHA Nation Pipeline Right-of-Way Terms and Conditions), and Resolution No. 15-045-LKH (Establishing a Procedure for the Approval of Leases, Rights-of-Way, Setback Variances and Permissions to Survey on Tribal Land), Resolution No. 17-117-FWF (Approval of Fee Structure), and Resolution No. 18-212-FWF (Amending Fee Structure); and
- WHEREAS, On June 24th, 2019 WPX Energy Williston, LLC submitted a ROW application for the Meadowlark 6-34H Pad Project, approved by the Tribal Business Council September 12th, 2019; and



- WHEREAS, WPX Energy Williston, LLC submitted an application to assign the Utility and Pipeline portions of the ROW for the Meadowlark 6-34H Pad Project to Crestwood Midstream Partners LP and McKenzie Electric Cooperative; and
- WHEREAS, The Pipeline and Utility ROW for this application consists of 1.230 acres for utility disturbance, 0.273 acres permanent Pipeline disturbance and 0.634 acres temporary Pipeline disturbance; the utilities will be 535.95 feet in length, and pipelines will be 394.95 feet in length; and
- WHEREAS, The ROW assignment request, described above, has been reviewed and recommended for approval in accordance with the MHA Nation's approved procedure for authorizing ROWs on Tribal Land.
- **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** the Tribal Business Council hereby approves the following ROW assignment(s):
 - Partial Assignment by WPX Energy Williston, LLC to Crestwood Midstream Partners LP – of the pipeline ROW for the Meadowlark 6-34H Pad Project Tract T636A, located in Section 27, Township 149 North, Range 92 West, in Dunn County, North Dakota.
 - Partial Assignment by WPX Energy Williston, LLC to McKenzie Electric Cooperative, Inc. – of the utility ROW for the Meadowlark 6-34H Pad Project across Tract T636A, located in Section 27, Township 149 North, Range 92 West, in Dunn County, North Dakota.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** That the assignees shall be subject to all applicable terms and conditions of the ROW for the Meadowlark 6-34H Pad Project.
- **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,** That the Chairman is hereby authorized to execute such documents and take such further actions as are necessary to carry out the terms and intent of this Resolution.
