RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution entitled, "Approval of a Temporary Use Permit Across Tribal Land for the Marathon Deep Creek Pad Submitted by Marathon Oil".

- WHEREAS, The Mandan Hidatsa and Arikara Nation (the "Nation"), also known as the Three Affiliated Tribes, having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, the authority under said Act, and having adopted a Constitution and Bylaws (the "Constitution") under said Act, and
- WHEREAS, Pursuant to Article III, Section 1 of the Constitution, the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, Pursuant to Article VI, Section 5(1) of the Constitution, the Tribal Business Council has the power to adopt Resolutions regulating the procedures of the Tribal Council, its Agencies and Officials; and
- WHEREAS, Article IX, Sections 1 and 3 of the Constitution, provides that the Tribal Business Council has the authority to manage and lease or otherwise deal with tribal lands and resources; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council has the authority to grant temporary use permits across tribal trust land; and
- WHEREAS, Marathon Oil submitted a Temporary Use Permit application for the Marathon Deep Creek Pad for a temporary above ground freshwater line 49.59 feet in length, 15 feet in width, 0.020 acres in size, across a certain tribal tract legally described as Section 13, Township 148 North, Range 96 West, NW ¼ NW ¼, Dunn County, North Dakota, with 100.00 % tribal interest; and
- WHEREAS, The Temporary Permit application, has been reviewed and recommended for approval.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Tribal Business Council authorizes and approves the attached Temporary Use Permit as follows:
 - To Marathon Oil for the Marathon Deep Creek Pad a temporary above ground fresh water line 49.59 feet in length, 15 feet in width, 0.020 acres in size, across a certain tribal tract legally described as Section 13, Township 148 North, Range 96 West, NW ¼ NW ¼, Dunn County, North Dakota, with 100.00 % tribal interest.
