

THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES TRIBAL BUSINESS COUNCIL NATURAL RESOURCE COMMITTEE MEETING 11-05-AS JULY 26, 2011, 1:00 P.M.

I. CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Strahs called the meeting to order at 2:51 P.M.

II. PRAYER:

Lyda Bearstail gave the invocation.

III. ROLL CALL:

Chairman Arnold Strahs, Councilman Scott Eagle, and Councilwoman V. Judy Brugh are present. A quorum is established.

IV. APPROVAL OF AGENDA:

V. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Councilman Eagle moved to approve of two sets of minutes. April 5, 2011 and The motion is seconded by Councilwoman Brugh.

VI. NADC/PTAC: Shawn Ironmaker 3:00

Councilman Eagle moved to approve Shawn Ironmaker of NADC/PTAC work with Leslie Morsette and Dominick Silletti. The motion is seconded by Councilwoman Brugh.

VIII. EARL SILK, BIA SUPERINTENDANT & DARRYL TURCOTTE, DEPUTY SUPERINTENDANT 3:11

Tom Wells is representing the BIA as Earl Silk and Darryl Turcotte could not be here. Discussion is held regarding McKenzie Electric not hooking up electricity on the reservation due to. Need to get info to them right away....Mandaree make clear that they are not under ground need a letter stating that. But not to home sites. Requirements – 20 to 30 minimum, but looking at additional width. CEO would like a letter stating clarification on the issue of underground to homesites and to wells. The oil companies stated they were paying 100% of the costs to their sites. TAT was under that understanding. Has the Kilowatts gone up?

Second issue-Trailer area at Thunder butte is being held hostage unless the tribe pays up. But these are individual home sites. There has to be a legal thought on it.

How wide are the rites of ways. BIA will get a letter back to the TAT.

On the homesites leases-The superintendant is asking for a resolution. Tom said the BIA had an audit and there are some findings. The tribe has never had to do a resolution on a homesite or oil lease before. This would hold up things even further.

Elbowoods Healthcare Resolution is needed by the BIA.

Can a well be protested in coming up to close to a healthcare facility? At this point it may be too late. Why weren't the TBC notified? The industrial commission will be notified by the NRC Administrator. Councilman Eagle will be assisted by Jeff Desjarlais in the matter.

BIA will address MEC but will give the NRC Chairman and administrator a copy.

There is other gravel but don't know what the intent is gravel is put aside and get a site that is usable and we van bet that out of there, Getting to be a eyesore and ddigging further into the source. Thunder Butte:

Some of them are leasing FEMA Trailer leased out at \$1000 MO. AND THEY ARE LIVING IN A TRAILER through the TribalHousing FEMA Trailers were not to be leased out unless they purchased them Lawrence should be contacted. No longer let them have the lots and who is responsible for those trailers. Crushed or whatever. Touch trailer then we would be responsible take them to tribal court and have them abandoned and we can have them crushed. No place to really take those trailers and its costing the tribe money can't get fema trailers in there demo or burn site over and its getting to be more and more. Got to do something with them axle demolish them right where they are sitting. Would that follow moved under the browensville, didn't go through the court procedures and if we went through the court process and have clay pits in Four Bears if they don't have toxic materials and have older trailers.

Homesite leases: Richard Mayer

Why is it taking so long for the paperwork to get done. Went over to the BIA and haven't received it made copies of original letters dated and received hey you got these and it didn't happen.

Some of these ladies have houses sitting on leases that haven't been done BIA people were supposed to be here and they were not available and give them a call and ask them to come over.

Issues on damages to that house: Kay Bell live in White Shield house zT131A 10 miles west of ws on 1804 Sept. basement and house put on the foundation water line relocated to two stock tanks and were told we would receive no sewer drainfield, or electricity, Garrison said they would put the pole and electricity in if they received money from the tribe roof has to be fixed egress is leasking water when it storms house is sinking in the yard has singles nothing was picked up and now tall grass and was told we would get a garage. Sister is on oxygen and is now living in WS living quarters, I was told I would be next after Maggie Yellow Bird's houses. My sister and I need a place to live within 30 days.

House was built by Dynamic and once they hit the foundation and if it was an elder housig should have been done by housing. BIA/Supt hasn't signed. June Schettler and its illegal for them to be there and the road that goes to into it not supposed to be there and has to be moved over and it should come straight to Doreen house. Ed Fox said he could go down there and inspect the road and if its tribal land it should be a good road. Dennis Fox and Lawrence and Rich worked on this. Elder homes not getting their leases signed by the BIA and not being finished properly deteriorating specific houses are Kay Bell and Dorreen Yellow Bird. Dorreen had all of her paperwork and there is

no water line because that hill is higher the plan was to have the water tower from Parshall Dorreens house has and they both need cisterns Kay needs to have the electricity and whenever you do a homesite and you guys didn't pay and you only pay ofr 500 ft. McLeans will do it and able to make payments for it. Where do we stand? Dorren has to pay \$400 and the tribe has to pay for the poles and we don't do now because they didn't pay. Bad debt deal. Some individual member and I gave her my deposit and because I am already on McLean Electricity I don't have to pay a deposit. Gloria Lone Fight seems to be having problems and they aren't done. I keep telling fight with Whitney Bell and the favorite saracasm I fight to get his paid and it becomes frustrating and I need another paper and its not even clear and its not put in a form that is not conducive and it holds up the process. One of the things we were waiting for was money and they passed and yet he's held me up and I've told and that's it ok to get this money after Dennis Rich and what's going on and this week we are starting to finally move forward. Landscaping and slow moving and the elders are designated that way. Doreen is not designated as an elder Kay Bell home is to be worked on next along with Roberta Bear until we get the loan working on finishing Magdalene. Purchasing handicapped assessable toilets and they are regular and we had to readjust and literally rip demo the entire bathroom. She did not have any current up date for water and emailed up to Chad and she was already approved and we found in her paperwork the Spt didn't sign. DYB had some other stuff the way they were classified, WS is moving without any money. One more in Shell Creek. Mike Driver put his as soon as possible and trying to move him in there. Trying to get to the elders home. Gloria was promised something in the council meeting Dynamic homes demoed the house. Real reason is when you put and they are not going to honor and they had a one of the first things I seen and gifts presented and when are you going to deliver this and they said they are not going to honor it. Dynamic didn't bring the house down. It wasn't going to help if Richard or Dennis could talk to them if you guys want to contact and we didn't want it to happen and we are going to have to give them a call. How long to finish a house about three weeks water damage inside. Order shingles from Dynamic not being stitched up and reconfirmed with Kenny. Roberta Bear should be done from 2 weeks and Kay bell should be done in about 4 weeks. If it got paid.

Kay Bell can stay with Doreen until and the electricity is not out there and they should get the electricity to do the floor and need some to operate tools. Generators? Resolve Kays. Gloria's a different issue. FEMA Trailers are coming in and every one that I put in is almost done and we can get another 80 FEMA Trailers that's what Ponderosa said. 30 foot campers some are a little bit bigger. Still looking into it. Talking about somebody leasing out the trailer in Thunder Butte. Handful of them before and they said they were given them homes and they had to pay the costs and go ahead. Chase wants us to fix they used to be a darker brown and its just sitting out there and it's not level and it's sitting on the hill. They need to be leveled and skirted. It's right next to Sadie Mann's. Whatever the cost is they have to pay for it nothing is free. I apologize to them I didn't what you told them about being evicted. Trying to do the elders in White Shield. Lone Fight to expedite and I don't have a problem as far as giving them something free and she was promised them. She is staying with her son. Suggestion to set her up with something if you will jar loose

wof one of those in one of those meetings. Arnie is holding on to lots in Mandaree. Why don't he jar loose of one of them If you have the lot we have the equipment and In the last council meeting. Another family displaced and waiting for pictures from Cliff. What about Evangeline Irwin and that is one of the things and she is living in a small camper and they are emergencies and if you could jar loose. There is no problem with land; old home place no problem if there is water and sewer. You could it along side and after the council disagreed and living with grand kids and she is going to be stuck and we as a council appropriate and get a house built, if we could do something temporary there is no problem and this is beyond capabilities and try to honor councils request. I will have Annette write a letter and I will sign it. Its going to be temporary for now until we can work something up when these houses and we are looking for work. Talked for Denny from Rocky Boy try to hit that as long as get in there and button it up. Thank you for coming over. Judy I need a letter for Evangeline. Ready for Myrna try to get a hold and I TAKE THEM OUT IN A FIELD AND burn them There is just no housing here. Taking them and stripped them out and can't put them in the landfill. Another chance to get another 80 and we can tag them and that's about ready to open them up. Housed over in Parshall and that's supposed to be going over to Garrison. AS-has brought to my attention instead of giving them a lump sum per pad per acre, if they can make annual payments per value. Im not sure how that will work and just idea that was brought up. Judy-I think if they bureau could meet t the allottees, and a lot of them don't own the mineral well, and if they could access and work out negotionation and at least have a nunu

If you're a mineral owner that .50% what is the scenario and need to be very cautious. Allottees negotiate higher

Dorreen Yellow Bird:

Holding cell 70,000 for disbursement to trucks, underlying occurfurs Free flowing spree we approached the BIA as it pertains to water depots 25 CFR and Water Depots on a reservation. ZThyey researched it and came up with nothing follow the rules for a oil wells. NEPA document is a disturbance of the land. Completed a survey and they compoleted and Jeff at the BIA tentative approval working with Howard Bemer coached by Jeff DeCharlieasis and Darryl Tourcotte. They forgot to tell you now you have to fill out a business license and they said there was none. They gave us a draft document of a housing lease and they stopped us because it had a lease for 50 years. Why didn't you say we could change the documents and we have to go back and get the docs, 39 day scoping periods hinderance is the BIA negotiated cos @ a \$1.00 a barrel. Business leade of 2.5 acres in the Van Hook area. We have leased some of those out and should pin point how much we going to put on and one of the things they were going to give us 7-10% in the proceeds and trying to work out Williams. We did what needs to be done so they are following no consistencies. Want to get trucks off the road. Certain criteria and to equally distribute points tabled that anyone that wanted to get a water Bartlett and West asking for a 30 day comment period.
