Thomas Burr introduction, he works at BIA. Have vacancies that need to be filled, Councilman Cory Spotted Bear asked if they could help in anyway to fill these 8 positions. Currently searching for an Oil & Gas Officer that works outside of the BIA. Several years ago Kayla put together a Stopping Plan and has been fighting to get this going. Councilman Fred Fox states this should have been done in 2008. Councilwoman Monica Mayer mentioned, it is emprative to put pressure to the Regional Office and to the Secretary of Interior. Councilman Fred Fox noted that the Superintendent needs to have good communication with the Chairman. The Fort Berthold Agency She just has Spencer and he does 150 ROW's a year. Councilman Fred Fox reminded Kayla Danks she needs to be at the TBC Meetings to inform everyone what is happening. August 10-11 is the first face to face Federal Partners meeting since the beginning of the pandemic & Fort Berthold is hosting this meeting.

B. Bureau of Land Management (BLM) – Loren Wickstrom, Field Manager

1) **Update** – Report Submitted

Month of May we received 5 APD's and processed 9. For fiscal year 21 October through May we received 104 APD's and processed 88. 120 APD's pending. Have some pending APD's within ½ of a mile from Lake Sacakawea. The NDFO is working on an environmental assessment for 6 EOG APD's on two pads 11½ miles South East of New Town, both pads are
