B. Medical K.P.S.C [HIPAA SENSITIVE]

K.P.S.C. [XXXXX] medical issues over the past 3-4 years and as result has a large outstanding medical bill. This bill reflects medical services between 6/8/2018 to 7/11/2019. It has been very difficult to get this resolved and I have tried many times to address this situation with Boon Group. \$25,000 in medical debts that was negotiated down to \$19,000. This was an unclaimed bill Boon had. Councilwoman Monica Mayer suggested K.P.S.C. to speak to Charity Yessilth or Pam Lewis for any future insurance questions. Councilwoman Monica Mayer motions to forward to Executive Committee for full payment.
