**D.** Good Road Recovery Center – *Dr. Joy Froelich, Director*Report submitted for the record. Reported that the amount of money they receive from tribal funds, they make that back in collections. Ms. Froelich presented a



proposal to the committee. The proposal is to allow the Point of Contacts (POC) to serve as Case Managers under MHA Recovery Services. This will be an extension of services to their daily duties. The P.O.C. (Point of Contact) department of MHA Recovery Services was created with three essential job functions that were needed be filled: Peer Support, Case Management, and Transportation. Within these primary job functions, our individual P.O.C's have been able to bridge services, serve as the initial contact for our members who wish to receive services within MHA Recovery Services, as well as continue to cultivate the culture of recovery that they have reached individually. Every P.O.C. within the department is a member of good standing in their respective modality of personal recovery. This trackable objective only serves to compound the effect they will have in their communities. With this record of personal success comes vital knowledge and experience in the arena of navigating the inevitable issues that follow us into this new way of living. Legal, familial, personal health and cultural shortcomings are not only common, but expected. Our P.O.C.s come into work every day with this already accomplished personally and would only seek to further establish roots of integrity and hard work through giving this back to our members. As the movement of personal recovery deepens in our communities, the need for enhanced services is vital. Our data shows that every client we come into contact with is touched and introduced to several layers of services with which they can grow and adapt. Utilizing the P.O.C's, especially on Fort Berthold will help to keep our clients current, accountable and on track to reach goals defined between the client and P.O.C. assigned to the case. As our P.O.C's are already full-time employees of MHA Nation, this added function will not incur further costs to our people. A review of Residential Techs job descriptions and what they do at GRRC.   - School Screenings for Pre Diabetes

Will ask to add some data. School Screenings for Pre diabetes in school age children. Request to forward to Executive Committee to get the paper published, this can be uses as a resource for the tribe. Sent permission slips were sent home with children, screened about 1,400 usually we have screened up to 1,200 students. Gwen Davis presented; she is the Director of the Diabetes Program. She gave an update about the program going into schools. She went through the data attained from the schools. (A1C, BMI) They will forward this Diabetes issue to Executive.

### Smile Network International.

School base dental office in the schools. This is all volunteer work. Councilwoman Monica Mayer wants to hold off on this until Dr. Martin can review. Councilwoman Monica Mayer feels we should have our dental building running first before contracting out. Councilman Fred Fox asked about the living situation for professionals that come into our communities, where would 5 dentists hired today where would we house them? Fort Berthold needs housing for all professionals. Councilman Robert White we should put up 300,000 from each segment budget to house professionals. Committee feels they should hold off on Smile for now. Mr. Eagle is in favor of SNI services and what they can provide. SNI is interested in doing some work here but they will not do the Child Background Questionnaire. Mr. Eagle state that they cannot work within our facility without the questionnaire. Councilwoman Monica Mayer spoke about the issue and stated that if they do not want to do the questionnaire and not be held accountable to and unforeseen problems with the patients then they should not be allowed to work in our homelands. The committee decided no on Smile Network International. Mr. Eagle spoke about the plans with FBRW and asked for approval to move forward with the plans. The Committee advised him to speak about it at Executive when he does his report.

### Health Services Organizational Chart

Councilwoman Monica Mayer talked about the Organizational Chart of the overall Health Services. The Tribal Programs Analyst (James Baker) should not



be involved in Recovery Services operations. The TPA is not on the work chart. This will be reaffirmed at Executive. Organizational chart, reconsider the org chart. We need to Reaffirm at Executive Committee and ratify at TBC. Councilman Fred Fox recommended that the Recovery Services be under Jared Eagle rather than James Baker. Councilwoman Monica Mayer was in agreement.

Councilwoman Monica Mayer suggests 1, have tribal maintenance go look at it any they are short staffed. 2, get a contractor and get an estimate. She has no money in her budget, Councilwoman Monica Mayer should come out of General fund. Ms. Poitra was advised to get three bids and bring it back to TBC for approval.

Ms. Poitra stated she will be on maternity leave soon for a couple of months and she is asking that a contract for Paula Snow to be the Acting the Director. The Contract will be from April 1, 2023 to April 1, 2024. This will be for \$40/hr. and not to exceed \$83,200. Nicole will be out a couple of months.

*Motion:* Councilman Robert White moved to forward Paula Snow Contract to Executive Committee. Councilman Fred Fox seconded the motion. Vote: 3-0-0. Motion carried.
