Would like access route to the tribe's land. The Corps of Engineer land and shore have eroded into the lake and lost surface due to it. Would like to do a land exchange. Attorney Pete Bruer is on the line. Councilman Cory Spotted Bear asked Jason Krueger on the line about getting this back years ago as wildlife. Councilman Cory Spotted Bear needs to take action to get this land back. Everything in green south of the Highway needs a legal description and an application. Working on a resolution for it. Councilman Cory Spotted Bear asked, what are the chances to get an access road, seems to think it will go through, Councilwoman Monica states we need make this happen.

Motion: Councilwoman Monica Mayer moved in support to get immediate access to get Army Corp of Engineers land back under high priority. Councilman Fred Fox seconded the motion. Vote: 3-0-0. Motion carried.

C. Northern Arizona University Scholarship

Requesting \$5,000 to set up a Native American scholarship program. Councilman Cory Spotted Bear asked how this will assist MHA. Councilwoman Monica Mayer this is a teaching school and could forward to TBC.

The committee agreed to negotiate it down to the appraisal price. After negotiations it will be brought back to the committee. \$449,596.00 total asking price. Appraised value of \$267,633.33.

Motion: Councilman Fred Fox moved proceed with negotiations and represent NRC. Councilwoman Monica Mayer seconded the motion. Vote: 3-0-0. Motion carried.



Discussion: Councilman Cory Spotted Bear will work with her on negotiations. Presently the next NRC will be on Jan 31st.
