

## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution Entitled: "Authorizing the MHA Emergency Operations Center to Apply for and Accept A North Dakota Department of Health (NDDOH) Initiative to Address Covid-19

Disparities Grant Program."

- WHEREAS, This Nation having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, and the authority under said Act and having adopted a Constitution and By-Laws pursuant to said Act; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes, also known as the Mandan, Hidatsa, and Arikara Nation ("Tribes" or "MHA Nation") generally authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the Tribes and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Article III of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides that the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 5(1) of the Constitution of the Three Affiliated Tribes provides the Tribal Business Council authority to adopt resolutions regulating the procedure of the Tribal Council and other Tribal Agencies and Tribal Officials of the Reservation.
- WHEREAS, In order to help meet the reservation wide need of more trained and available community members with EMR and EMT Certifications to provide patient care thru local Emergency Medical Services and tribal healthcare programs, the Emergency Operations Center intends to apply for available grant funding through the NDDOH Initiative to Address Covid-19 Disparities Grant Program for FY2022; and
- WHEREAS, The amount to be requested from NDDOH is \$9,200.00 with a total project amount of \$9,200.00.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council of the Three Affiliated Tribes finds that application for and acceptance of such grant funding would benefit the health, welfare, and safety of the Tribes, its enrolled members, and local Emergency Services; and



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal Business Council hereby authorizes and supports the MHA Emergency Operations Center in making a grant submission for the NDDOH Initiative to Address Covid-19 Disparities Grant Program in the amount of \$9,200.00 for the purposes specified above; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to execute such documents and take such further actions as are necessary to carry out the terms and intent of this Resolution.

## CERTIFICATION
