

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE THREE AFFILIATED TRIBES OF THE FORT BERTHOLD INDIAN RESERVATION

A Resolution Entitled, "Providing Tribal Consent for Communitization Agreement NDM-105002 Implicating Tribal Mineral Interests"

- WHEREAS, The Mandan Hidatsa and Arikara Nation (the "Nation"), also known as the Three Affiliated Tribes, having accepted the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, the authority under said Act, and having adopted a Constitution and By-laws (the "Constitution") under said Act, and
- **WHEREAS,** Pursuant to Article III, Section 1 of the Constitution, the Tribal Business Council is the governing body of the Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, The Constitution authorizes and empowers the Tribal Business Council to engage in activities on behalf of and in the interest of the welfare and benefit of the MHA Nation and of the enrolled members thereof; and
- WHEREAS, Pursuant to Article VI, Section 5(1) of the Constitution, the Tribal Business Council has the power to adopt Resolutions regulating the procedures of the Tribal Council, its Agencies and Officials; and
- **WHEREAS,** Article IX, Sections 1 and 3 of the Constitution, provides that the Tribal Business Council has the authority to manage and lease or otherwise deal with tribal lands and resources; and
- WHEREAS, Leases and Rights-of-Way ("ROWs") across Tribal Trust land require the consent of the Tribal Business Council pursuant to federal and Tribal Law; and
- WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) prepared and transmitted to the Tribe Communitization Agreement NDM-105002 implicating tribal mineral resources under Indian Mineral Development Act leases; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Business Council believes it is in the best interest of the Tribe to provide consent for CA NDM-105002 identified in Attachment A and further described in Attachment B.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Tribal Business Council hereby approves and provides tribal consent for Communitization Agreement NDM-105002 identified in Attachment A and further described in Attachment B.



BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, The Chairman of the Tribal Business Council shall have the authority to execute all documents necessary to provide tribal consent for Communitization Agreement NDM-105002 and take such further actions as are necessary to carry out the terms and intent of this Resolution.
