Facts & Stats

ABOUT YOUNG DRIVERS

Teenagers, and parents alike, perceive a driver's license as a ticket to freedom. But the price is steep. Crashes are the leading cause of death among American teens.

30 young drivers die EVERY DAY in the US due to car crashes.

Young drivers, ages 14 to 24, are **4** times more likely to die in a car crash than older, more experienced drivers.

Motor vehicle crashes are the **#1** cause of death for people ages 14 to 24.

36 of them died on North Dakota's roads in 2012.

Safety belt use is the lowest by people ages 14 to 24.

For every 10 miles per hour over 50 mph, the risk of death in a traffic crash is doubled.

The fatal crash risk for young drivers is about **3** times higher with 3 or more passengers, than when the young driver is alone.
