By applying for a temporary surface water permit, Permitholder agrees to abide by the conditions listed below. This list of conditions is not exhaustive. The Water Department reserves the right to implement and enforce additional conditions as needed.

1. Full compliance with the MHA Nation Water Use and Administration Code.
2. New or additional water diversion or damming from existing streams is not authorized until the permit is reviewed and approved.
3. The Tribal Water Department may impose minimum flow restrictions.
4. The Water Department reserves the right to cancel a permit for lack of use if the project is not implemented within a reasonable amount of time.
5. **A weather-protected copy of the temporary water permit must be present and on display at the equipment withdrawing water and the industrial depot at all times.**
6. A water metering requirement will eventually be put in place. More information will be shared with Permitholders as it becomes available.
7. The permitholder must complete an Annual Water Use Report, even if no water is withdrawn, within thirty (30) days after expiration of the permit. The report must include the total water withdrawn within the permit period.
8. Any works associated with this temporary water permit are subject to inspection at any time by representatives of the Tribal Water Department. Refusal to allow inspection is grounds for temporary water permit cancellation.
9. Failure to comply with any order of the Tribal Water Department may result in temporary or permanent water permit forfeiture.
